

The Will of Peter Seaman 1761

This is Last Will and Testament of me Peter Seaman of Weeting in the County of Norfolk farmer.

I give and bequeath all my real and personal estate whatsoever and wheresoever which I am now or maybe entitled unto at the time of my decease unto my dear wife Elizabeth Seaman forever (she paying all my just debts and funeral expenses) and lastly I make and appoint and ordain my dear wife Elizabeth Seaman aforesaid sole executrix of this my last Will and Testament.

In witness thereof I have to this my last Will and Testament containing one sheet of paper set my hand and seal this Thirteenth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Sixty One.
